
Sub: - Not to allow loading of Iron Ores at the loading points.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above I am to inform you that the Collector & District Magistrate, Jagatsingpur vide his letter No 2288 dated 09-09-2011 has reported that there is long line of kilometers of iron ore loaded trucks waiting along the express Highway (NH 5A) for unloading at Paradeep which is causing heavy Traffic jam and as a result other vehicles including emergency vehicles are not able to pass through that route. In view of flood situation it is urgently necessary to keep the Express Highway clear for smooth plying of emergency vehicles to be used for rescue and relief operation and transportation of relief materials. Further the Superintendent of Police, Jagatsingpur has requested that not to allow loading of iron ores at the loading points till flood situation is normalized.

You are therefore requested to stop loading of iron ores to the trucks from 10.09.2011 to 18.09.2011.
