Selection Process

Step-1 -Short listing of Candidates based on the eligibility criteria as given below

Eligibility Criteria:

1. The candidate must have a Bachelor degree in Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (B.A.M.S) / Bachelor in Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S) from a recognized university.
2. S/he should have passed Oriya up to M.E. Standard.
3. Should have registered in the Ayurvedic / Homeopathic council.
4. However, allopathic doctors if in position will continue as before.
5. **AGE:** The candidate should be under 37 years and over 21 years of age on 01.06.2009 and the upper age limit as prescribed will be relaxable only for the categories mentioned below:
 - a. Up to a maximum of 5 yrs if a candidate belongs to S.C/ S.T or women or ex- servicemen.
 - b. Up to a maximum of 3 Yrs in the case of candidates belonging to S.E.B.C.
 - c. To maximum of 10 yrs in case of Physically challenged candidates.

Step-2-listing of Sort listed candidates as per order of local preference

Selection will be made block wise MHU.Applications will be sorted out in the following manner for preparing separate lists. The following shall be in the order of preference.

1. Applications of the candidates belonging to the same block- **List -1**
2. Applications of the candidates belonging to the peripheral blocks (touching Geographical boundary) within the district -**List-2**
- 3.Applications of the candidates of other blocks within the same district -**List-3**
- 4.Applications of the candidates belonging to the peripheral districts (touching Geographical boundary)-**List-4.**
- 5.Applications of the candidates belonging to the other districts -**List-5**

Step-3

Consideration of Weightage of marks secured if more than one eligible candidature for a position.

Weightage shall be calculated on the basis of marks of BHMS / BAMS Exams combined with career weightage in the following manner separately for the above categories as mentioned in step-1.

No interview shall be conducted for the purpose.

If a candidate from the same block as that of the block to which the MHU is allocated then he/she shall get priority. If more than one candidate is from that block than selection should be done on the basis merit..

II.Engagement of Paramedics

1.Health Worker (F)

Step-1 –Short listing of Candidates based on the eligibility criteria given below

Eligibility Criteria

Educational Qualification :Matriculation +ANM course for 1 yr & 6 months

With valid registration certificate of Orissa Nursing Council

AGE: The candidate should be under 32 years and over 21 years of age on 01.06.2009 and the upper age limit as prescribed will be relaxable only for the categories mentioned below:

- a. Up to a maximum of 5 yrs if a candidate belongs to S.C/ S.T or women
- b. Up to a maximum of 3 Yrs in the case of candidates belonging to S.E.B.C.
- C. Up to maximum of 10 yrs in case of Physical challenged candidates.

Step-2- Applications will be sorted out in the following manner for preparing separate lists. The following shall be in the order of preference.

1. Candidate belonging to the block will be given priority in engagement –List-1
2. Applicant belonging to the peripheral blocks (touching Geographical boundary) within the district-List-2
3. Applications of the candidates of other blocks within the same district –list-3
4. Applications of the candidates belonging to the peripheral districts (touching Geographical boundary)-List-4
5. Applications of the candidates belonging to the other districts –list-5

Step-3

Preference on the basis of Institutional status

Preference should be given to the candidate from Government Institute & selection should be done on the basis of marks secured in matriculation. If no candidate is available from Government institution, then, candidate from private institution should be considered on merit basis.

No interview shall be conducted for the purpose.

2. Pharmacist

Step-1 –Short listing of candidates based on the eligibility criteria given below

Eligibility Criteria

a) Educational Qualification: Diploma in Pharmacy

b) AGE: The candidate should be under 32 years and over 21 years of age on 01.06.2009 and the upper age limit as prescribed will be relaxable only for the categories mentioned below:

- a. Up to a maximum of 5 yrs if a candidate belongs to S.C/ S.T or women or ex- servicemen.
- b. Up to a maximum of 3 Yrs in the case of candidates belonging to S.E.B.C.
- c. To maximum of 10 yrs in case of PH candidates.

Step-2-List of short listed candidates as per local preference

- 1.Candidate belonging to the block will be given priority in engagement –List-1
- 2.Applicant belonging to the peripheral blocks (touching Geographical boundary) within the district-List-2
- 3.Applications of the candidates of other blocks within the same district –list-3
- 4.Applications of the candidates belonging to the peripheral districts (touching Geographical boundary)-List-4
- 5.Applications of the candidates belonging to the other districts –list-5

Step-3-Preference on the basis of Institutional status

Preference should be given to the candidate from Government Institute & selection should be done on the basis of marks secured in Pharmacy examination. If no candidate is available from Government institution, than, candidate from private institution should be considered & on merit basis.

No interview shall be conducted for the purpose.

3. Attendant-cum-Sweeper

Attendant-cum-Sweeper should be engaged on daily wages or by any other procedures with the approval of collector-cum-chairman, EC, ZSS.

Committee responsible for verification of certificate & necessary processing for engagement of all categories under MHU:

This committee shall be chaired by the Chief District Medical Officer & should comprise of the following members:

- i) ADMO(FW)
- ii) Representative of Collector
- iii) DPM- Member Convener
- iv) DHIO

Other Conditions for all categories of posting under MHU

- Waiting list to be maintained & should be valid for 1 yr from the date of approval of the panel of selected candidates.(only if vacancies arises under MHU)
- ORV Act is not applicable.
- The engagement is purely contractual in nature and can be terminated at any point without citing any reasons thereof.
- Candidates once engaged cannot claim for re-engagement under any conditions as a matter of right.
- The contract is initially for a period of 11months and further extension if any, will be provided on assessment of the performance of the period in service.
- Candidate appointed on contractual basis will not claim for inter-district transfer.
- These engagements are **non-transferable** in nature and the candidates have to stay at their place of posting failing which they are liable to be disengaged.
