

The tender is to be submitted for Mid-Day-Meal Scheme and Supplementary Nutrition Programme separately.

The cost of tender paper is ₹ 5000.00 (Rupees five thousand) only inclusive of VAT. This amount is not refundable.

Detailed terms and conditions for appointment of transporting agent under Supplementary Nutrition Programme for the year 2011-12

1. Sealed tenders in the prescribed form are invited from intending firms/individuals for undertaking lifting and transportation of rice/wheat from different FCI depots to Anganwadi Centres/WSHGs in Keonjhar district under Supplementary Nutrition Programme for the year 2011-12. Approximately Q.72000.00 rice/wheat is to be handled whose value is ₹ 4,06,80,000/-
2. The tender papers giving details regarding terms and conditions, earnest money deposit etc. can be obtained by downloading from Keonjhar District website <http://www.kendujhar.nic.in>. The cost of tender paper is ₹ 5000.00 (Rupees five thousand) only inclusive of VAT. This amount is not refundable. The tenderer should enclose a demand draft issued by any Nationalized Bank in favour of "District Social Welfare Officer, Keonjhar" payable at "Keonjhar" in the tender towards the cost of tender paper.
3. 
7. The tenderer shall furnish an affidavit to the effect that it is not engaged in any PDS /rice mill business.
8. The tenderer shall furnish an affidavit to the effect that it is not involved in any criminal activity.
9. The successful tenderer shall be required to lift rice/wheat from different FCI depots and transport the same stock of rice/wheat **directly** to Anganwadi Centres/WSHG's of Keonjhar district within the stipulated time as per instructions to be issued by the Collector /DSWO, Keonjhar from time to time.
10. The tender paper should be filled properly and legibly without any correction/overwriting and must be Typed/Computerized. The rate should be written both in figures and words in the tender schedule. The rate quoted should be final and the tenderer shall not be allowed to change it under any circumstances.
11. a) Recent solvency certificate for ₹ 15.00 lakh only issued in 2011-12 by the competent authority must be furnished along with the tender paper.
- b) Earnest money of ₹ 4 lakh only @ 1% of the total value of foodstuff as shown in clause 1 of the terms and conditions in shape of NSC/KVP/Term deposit duly pledged in favour of the Collector, Keonjhar shall be furnished along with the tender. Cash, Cheques and Demand Drafts will not be accepted. No tenderer shall be allowed to withdraw its tender/earnest money deposit until the tender is finalized. The E.M.D. of unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded to them after finalization of the tender process. In case the successful tenderer refuses to be the transporting agent after acceptance of its tender, earnest money deposited by it will be liable for forfeiture.
- c) Earnest money deposited by the successful tenderer shall stand converted to security deposit, which will be refunded after successful completion of contract period and audit of relating accounts. The whole or part of the

- security deposit will be forfeited for irregular performance or breach of any term(s) and condition(s) of agreement during the period of contract.
- d) The successful tenderer will be required to furnish a minimum bank guarantee of ₹ 4.00 lakh only for the period of contract from the date of signing the agreement or for such period as would be required by the Collector, Keonjhar.
- e) The tenderer shall submit attested copy of PAN card along with the tender paper.
12. Telegraphic tenders and conditional tenders will not be accepted.
13. The tenderer should own/have taken on lease such number of trucks so that it is able to lift and transport at least Q.1300.00 rice/wheat as per Govt. norm on each lifting day so that the process is completed in approximately 7 lifting days in each month.
14. The tenderer is required to possess valid agents' license under OMV (Licencing of Agents Rules 1990) valid for Keonjhar district.
15. The successful tenderer shall have to enter into a registered agreement with the Collector, Keonjhar as per terms and conditions specified by the Collector, Keonjhar in the agreement form at its own cost within 7 days of intimation of acceptance of its tender.
16. The work is to be carried out with due diligence and in accordance with the instructions to be issued from time to time by the Collector/DSWO, Keonjhar or any other authorized official.
17. The approved transporting agent will submit the bill once in a month to the DSWO, Keonjhar on completion of delivery of stock of foodstuff at their destination as per order of the competent authority accompanying delivery challans/way bills meant for the purpose and duly acknowledged by the authorized recipients.
18. Payment should be made as per approved rate to be incorporated in the agreement. No advance payment will be made.

19. Payment will be made against submission of bills subject to availability of funds meant for the purpose in the district. The approved transporting agent, for delayed payment to it, can claim no interest.
20. No request for enhancement of approved rate shall be entertained during the term of the agreement.
21. The Collector, Keonjhar may terminate the contract for violation of terms of agreement or for any other reasons to be recorded in writing.
22. a) The tender will be finalized after obtaining approval of Govt., if required.
b) Any type of canvassing for the purpose will lead to rejection of the tender.
c) No preference shall be given to any tenderer on any terms and conditions.
23. The tenderer has to submit the following documents at the time of submission of tender paper in the sealed cover.
a) Bank draft of ₹5,000/- towards cost of tender paper.
b) Attested copy of PAN card.
c) Attested copy of valid agent's license from competent authority.
d) Earnest money deposit of ₹ 4.00 lakh in shape of KVP/NSC/Term deposit pledged in favour of the Collector, Keonjhar.
e) Affidavit regarding non-engagement of the tenderer in PDS/Rice mill business.
f) Affidavit regarding non-involvement of the tenderer in criminal activities


